... And So Enter Into His Glory!

We have spent forty days preparing for this Feast of Easter and now the Church invites us to spend fifty days celebrating it! The next six weekends are not described as the Sundays AFTER Easter, but the Sundays OF Easter. It is as if we have seven Easter Sundays, which will climax with the Feasts of the Ascension of the Lord and Pentecost, the sending of the Spirit. In doing so, the Church reminds us that Easter is not an event, but a process. It is not as if Jesus rose from the dead and that's the end of the story! What did he rise for? And the answer is: to share life with his God and share his Spirit with us.

To do this the Church borrows a uniquely Lucan timeline, forty days to Ascension and fifty days to the sending of the Spirit. In the original version of Mark's Gospel, there were no resurrection appearances, with the Gospel finishing with the women running away from the tomb because they were afraid (*Mark 16/8*). Sometime later some well-meaning soul decided to add an appendix, summarizing most of the Resurrection appearances from the other Gospels (*Mark 16/9-20*). In Matthew, Jesus appears to the women (who by the way are leaving the tomb filled with awe and great joy, not fear! (*Matthew 28/8*)) to tell them to pass on the message that he will catch up with them in Galilee (*Matthew 28/10*), where they receive a commission from Jesus to go out to all the world (*Matthew 28/16-20*) without any indication as to where Jesus heads off to after that, except that he will be with them to the end of time (*Matthew 28/20*).

Next to Luke, John probably has the most extended post-resurrection experience. Not only does Jesus appear to Mary Magdalene and later on to the apostles on the day of Resurrection (*John 20/11-23*) where, by the way, he gives them the Holy Spirit, but he also drops in 8 days later to make himself known to Thomas (*John 20/24*). There is also an appendix to the Gospel in which Jesus appears to the disciples by the Sea of Tiberias at an unnamed later date and commissions Peter (*John 21*).

But it is Luke who gives us the most extended series of appearances of Jesus after the Resurrection and, surprisingly, not in the Gospel. In the Gospel, Jesus seems to have a very full Easter Sunday! He appears to the disciples on the way to Emmaus (*Luke 24/13-32*), then fits in a visit to Peter (*Luke 24/35*) before appearing to the Eleven apostles who have been joined by the disciples who have rushed back from Emmaus to share their story (*Luke 24/36ff*), where he shows them his hands and feet and eats a piece of fish to assuage their concerns. All this happens in Jerusalem, not Galilee, and he takes them out to Bethany where he ascends to heaven in their sight (*Luke 24/50*). All this seems to be presented as following on immediately one after the other!

But at the beginning of the Acts of the Apostles, it is a different story. While the themes are the same, the timeline is not. He continues to appear to the disciples for a period of forty days, during which he continued to instruct them about the Kingdom (*Acts 1/3*), at the end of which time he was taken up into heaven from the Mount of Olives (*Acts 1/12*) (the Ascension!) and they were told to go back to Jerusalem to await the coming of the Holy Spirit. They do what they are told and, joined by a number of women including Mary, Jesus' mother, they devote themselves to prayer and electing a replacement for Judas (*Acts 1/23ff*) while they await developments. Then on Pentecost, the fiftieth day, the Spirit does come and propel them into ministry (*Acts 2/1ff*).

So you can see how much it is Luke who gives us our pattern for celebrating the Easter event!


