Laudato Si Action Plan

"2021-2022 Social Justice Statement: Cry of the Earth, Cry of the Poor. It established a working group chaired by Bishop Vincent Long OFM Conv, chair of the Bishops Commission for Social Justice, Mission and Service. The Office for Justice, Ecology and Peace is tasked with coordinating the plan's development and implementation. During the Fifth Plenary Council of Australia, the Church encouraged all Catholics to embrace a commitment to ecological conversion. As a result, every parish and diocese around Australia will need to be involved in a plan like the one the Bishops Conference has developed.

Caritas Australia has been asked by the bishops to support parishes and dioceses in the implementation of this decision. At its May 2023 plenary meeting, the Bishops Conference endorsed the first iteration of the plan, which covers 2023-25.

Further actions will be added in the coming years for the full seven-year commitment timeline. The Bishops Conference launched its plan on June 5, World Environment Day."

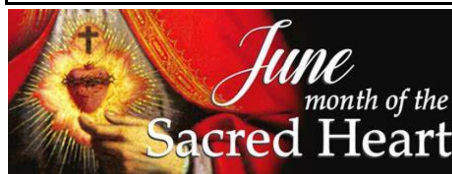

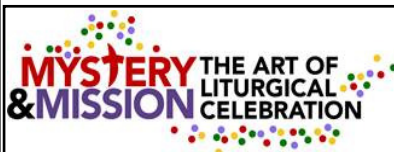

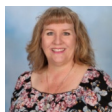
