### Important Announcement from the Archbishop.

Holy Spirit Church Harriett Street, Auchenflower

TO THE PEOPLE OF GOD OF THE PARISH OF HOLY FAMILY PARISH, INDOOROOPILLY ST THOMAS AQUINAS PARISH, ST LUCIA ST IGNATIUS PARISH, TOOWONG

Over recent months I have held meetings with your pastors and parish councils in light of the impending retirements later this year of Fr Wrex Woolnough and Fr Patrick Richards.

The Provincial of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits) wrote to me recently seeking to reestablish a community in the Archdiocese of Brisbane in 2024.

After consultation I have granted permission to the Jesuits to establish a community and occupy the presbytery at St Lucia. The Jesuit community will comprise Frs Gregory Jacobs, Frank Brennan and Paul Fyfe.

Fr Greg has been nominated as the Parish Priest (St Lucia) and Administrator (Indooroopilly and Toowong) and I have asked him to work with the parishes to develop a model of collaborative leadership to form what we might call a 'community of communities'. Fr Fyfe will be Associate Pastor and Fr Brennan will provide sacramental ministry on a parttime basis.

As this year progresses I will discuss with Fr Michael Grace options for his ministry following the arrival of the Jesuit community.

I am sure you will join me in welcoming this news.






