## National Child Protection Week 2023 & Safeguarding Sunday 2023

This week we celebrated *National Child Protection Week* (3—9 September 2023). focusing on ways we can all work together to build communities, so we can support our children and families. This Sunday, 10 September, we celebrate Safeguarding Sunday; this year's theme: Supporting Safe Communities.

Children are best able to feel safe and comforted when they are listened to, respected and believed. All adults can play a role by "tuning in" to children in everyday situations about *small* worries, so that they may feel more comfortable and more likely to tell us if something big is wrong. The Archdiocese has called each of us to embrace our Christian duty to care for the well-being and protection of children, young people and people

at risk in our community. This is our commitment to create safe environments for all and we implement all of our practices (blue cards, police checks and training) so children and families feel safe in our churches and schools. We can all play our part by supporting parents, being involved in your local community, taking time to engage with children & to believe them, speak up if something is unsafe, educate ourselves to know the signs and risks. This is all about how we can work together to create great lives for all our precious children, truly a Gift from God.



#### A MESSAGE TO THE CHILDREN OF ST IGNATIUS PARISH.

This day, (and <u>every</u> day), we want to remind you and all the adults around you, that you are loved very much by Jesus, by our St Ignatius community and that it is your right to ALWAYS feel safe. Remember there is always something you can do if you don't feel safe. Sometimes it can be because of someone's words, in person or online, or physically hurting or touching you in a way you don't want. This is never ok!! And never your fault.



#### New CBA Smart Terminals are being trialled at St Ignatius Church.

Our Parish has now received two devices, to be positioned at church doors at weekend Masses, to receive your electronic donations. A great option for those wanting to give, but not carrying cash to put in collection basket.

#### To use, it is as simple as:

1. Choose the amount you would like to give, by touching the device screen (on \$5, \$10, \$20 or 'other amount'),

2. Then tap your credit card or smart phone over the device (as you would for any other electronic purchase).

As always, the Parish is forever grateful for any donation you are able to make and for your ongoing support of our parish. If you require any assistance with using the device, please speak to the Sacristan (at the Mass you are attending). Thank you.
