Easter Sunday - Removing the Mask

I don't know that I ever really believed in the Easter Bunny, I certainly did believe in Santa Claus – but I don't remember at what age I stopped or why? There are many such 'coming of age' stories and cultures around the world that foster such maturing moments. It is a moment of disenchantment when we lose one image or understanding of the world and are asked to accept something else. When the masks are removed, we undergo a death experience. The secure world that we once knew is shattered, certitude dissolves into doubt. The disciples of Jesus knew this feeling well. Their Master had been executed as a criminal, his dead body laid to rest in a borrowed tomb. They, meanwhile, all fled in fear.

Disenchantment needs to be replaced by something else, to discover the reality behind the masks. As the disciples were soon to discover, disenchantment is an experience more of discovery than of loss. Easter removes one of the veils, one of the masks, that hid a deeper reality of Jesus' identity. He whose lifeless body was laid to rest in the tomb has shattered the bars and burst through the gates of death. He who is risen from the dead remains with his disciples forever.

One writer has said that a successful marriage requires falling in love many times, always with the same person. In other words, marriage ought to be a spiralling journey in which we constantly cast-off masks in order to know the other at a deeper level. Such love might be called, instead, *enchantment*! – to be taken up into something mystical. This enchantment could equally be used for our loving relationship with God. Easter becomes our chance, after letting some things go during Lent, of experiencing a 'disenchantment' with an old reality, to finally allow a new reality to emerge in Easter joy.

We will spend the next 50 days trying to describe and live this new reality.

Holy Spirit Church will close on **Monday 8 April** while the roof is replaced. The period of closure is subject to weather but is likely to be for 4—6 weeks.

Unfortunately, there is no alternative option for 8 am Mass for the duration of the roof work on Holy Spirit Church. New CBA Smart Terminals are being trialled at St Ignatius Church and Holy Spirit Church.

After a successful trial of the electronic payment device at St Ignatius Church Toowong, we will now be trialling one at Holy Spirit Church Auchenflower.

The devices are positioned at church doors at weekend Masses, to receive your electronic donations. It's great option for those wanting to give, but not carrying cash to put in the collection basket.

To use, it is as simple as:

1. Choose the amount you would like to give, by touching the device screen (on \$5, \$10, \$20 or 'other amount'), 2. Then tap your credit card or smart phone over the device (as you would for any other electronic purchase).

As always, the Parish is forever grateful for any donation you are able to make and for your ongoing support of our parish. If you require any assistance with using the device, please speak to the Sacristan (at the Mass you are attending). Thank you.
