Lent 3: Law and Temple

The Temple was not only the place where believers went to offer sacrifice to God; it was also the place where God dwelt in the midst of the people. It was the place where the world above and the world below come into conjunction with the world of history, thus enabling the three worlds to communicate.

The incident in today's gospel is the cause of Jesus' arrest and death. By his action Jesus had demonstrated that the worship carried out in the Temple was vain in God's eyes and must be superseded. To the Temple authorities this was intolerable and must be removed. Again, Jesus demanded a complete reversal of standards. This tension rises each time Jesus visits Jerusalem.

Jesus' puzzling saying about building the Temple anew in his body was at last understood by his disciples to mean the Temple that was his Body, the Church. The material building which had been the centre of worship was no longer important. Henceforth all worship would take place in any place, but within the Christian community. The community – or the Church – was now the place of sanctification and of prayer to God.

Alongside this is the teaching of the Commandments. Although the law is considered by some to be a rigid set of precepts, it is really more a collection of directives that have grown out of the experience of life. The Hebrew word *torah* might best be understood as "instruction" or "teaching". Thus the law is really a kind of codified wisdom. It is accorded the highest praise because it points to God, points us to the Wisdom of God in Jesus Christ.

We too are helped then by these two great pillars – the law and the Church – but also face the same temptations that hindered the Israelites: turning the law and Church into institutions that in fact turn us away from the Wisdom of God, when both, used properly certainly do point us to God through Jesus.

The devices are positioned at church doors at weekend Masses, to receive your electronic donations. It's great option for those wanting to give, but not carrying cash to put in the collection basket.

To use, it is as simple as:

- 1. Choose the amount you would like to give, by touching the device screen (on \$5, \$10, \$20 or 'other amount'),
- 2. Then tap your credit card or smart phone over the device (as you would for any other electronic purchase).
