## St Ignatius Parish Planning Day

Twenty-five representatives of Parish Ministries, congregations and the Faber Centre attended a planning day held on Saturday $20^{\text {th }}$ April to discern ways forward for the St Ignatius Parish in 2024 and beyond.
The group explored the Ignatian essential dispositions and attitudes for Apostolic planning as outlined in a video presentation by Dr Christina Kheng who is a planning consultant with the Jesuit Conference of Asia Pacific. The Essential Dispositions outlined were: Loving kindness toward yourself, Allowing God to lead, Desire for the Magis, Communion is the primary reality: Community is a priority, and Being willing to stay with the question and willing to take action. These are important guidelines for planning in the Parish as we move forward with the process for discernment and implementation of priorities.
Presentations by Dr Anthong Young (Music Ministry Leader), Sue Suter (A/Principal St Ignatius School) and Liz Kerr (Spiritual Director, The Faber Centre) provided the group with insights into strategies for maintaining vibrant communities in our Parish which is a priority nominated by parishioners in the surveys conducted in 2023. The group learned of the importance of having a clear mission, engagement with community and partnering with other Ministries in the Parish.
Fr Gregory initiated a review of the Parish Mission statement and its relevance for planning and the culture of the Parish. Our Mission Prayer embodies powerful concepts of 'knowing Jesus in prayer, scripture and liturgy' which need to be practised and taken into our everyday being. Improving our knowledge and understanding our mission will be an important element of our Formation development.
The group was introduced to the processes of Synodality and Engagement with the Spirit as they began to explore three of the eight priorities discerned from the Parish survey data. The workshop focused on: - Formation, Adult and Family Ministries and Growing Lay Leaders. The Feedback from the findings from the Discernment in Common process related to the three priorities at the Workshop will be provided by the Parish priests and the PPC over the coming weeks.
The next steps in the process will involve wider community consultation within the Parish. There will also be opportunities for parishioners to engage in the Synodality and discernment process as actions regarding each of the priorities are the subject of wider engagement. The members of Ministries who attended the workshop will also be engaged in this work as part of their Ministry.
